Department of Employment and Training - Training Wing - Budget Speech made by the Hon'ble Minister for Finance and Environment Climate Change during the Assembly Session 2025-2026 - Starting of 7 new Government Industrial Training Institutes with hostel facilities at Krishnagiri, Thiruvallur, Kancheepuram, Thirupparankunram, Manachanallur, Perur, and Karimangalam for the wards of construction workers - Administrative and Financial Sanction for a sum of **Rs. 60,18,52,000/-** from the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board funds - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

During the Budget session, 2025-2026, the Hon'ble Minister for Finance and Environment Climate Change, on 14.03.2025, among others has made the following Budget Speech on the floor of the Assembly: -

"Government will establish 7 new Government Industrial Training Institutes with hostel facilities in districts with high population of construction workers, namely, Krishnagiri in Krishnagiri district, Tiruvallur in Tiruvallur District, Kancheepuram in kancheepuram District, Manachanallur in Trichy district, Perur in Coimbatore district and Karimangalam in Dharmapuri District to provide vocational training to the wards of construction workers at a cost of Rs. 148 crore from the funds of the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board".

2. In the letter first read above, the Director of Employment and Training, has sent proposals for starting 7 new Government Industrial

P.T.O.,

Training Institutes (ITIs) with hostel facilities for the wards of construction workers, as detailed below:-

- The wards and dependents of construction workers hailing in unserved and under-served places should also get an opportunity to obtain skill training to uplift their livelihood.
- High quality skill training enhances employment and supports economic development. It is also a powerful means of empowering youth to develop their full capabilities, thereby increasing the productivity of both workers and industry.
- Establishing new Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in construction workers concentrated areas and industrial areas will enhance the number of skilled work force required to meet the demand of industries and also benefit the wards of construction workers in those areas.
- In the following areas there are no Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) to benefit the wards of construction workers and also to the industries located therein :-

I. Trades to be started in each ITI

Proposed to start 3 Industry 4.0 Trade, 1 modern trade and 1 demand driven conventional trade.

- II. The proposal for construction of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) will be sent on receipt of Detailed Estimate from the Public Works Department. Till then the Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) will be functioning on rental premises at a monthly rent of Rs.60,000/- per each Industrial Training Institute (ITI). So, a sum of Rs.50.40 lakh as recurring expenditure is required towards rental charges.

III. Cost of tools and equipment

Approximate cost for purchase of tools and equipment has been arrived based on the latest purchase prices available.

IV. Staff details

3. In the letter second read above, the Commissioner of Labour has stated that, the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board has given the following consent for establishing 7 new Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) with hostel facilities for the wards of the construction workers in accordance with the provisions of the Model Welfare Scheme:-

- To meet out the non-recurring expenditure towards construction of Industrial Training Institute (ITI) buildings with Hostel from the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board fund as per the detailed estimate of the Public Works Department.
- To meet out the non-recurring expenditure of Rs.4503.75 lakh (Rs.4285 lakh towards purchase of machineries, tools & equipment, Rs.91 lakh for computer and accessories, Rs.84 lakh for furniture and Rs.43.75 lakh for hostel kitchen utensils) for 7 Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) from the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board Fund.
- To meet out and reimburse to the Government the recurring expenditure of Rs.1590.86 (1402.47 lakh for ITI & Rs.188.39 lakh for hostel) towards salaries to staff, rent, other contingencies, stationery, oil & lubricants, maintenance of machineries and computers, raw materials, etc., for 7 Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) from the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board fund.

4. After careful examination of the of proposal of the Director of Employment and Training, the Government accord permission to start 7 new Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), for the wards of construction workers, in the following unserved areas with the trades mentioned in the **Annexure-I**: -

5. The Government also accord Administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.45,03,75,000/- as non-recurring expenditure towards purchase of machineries, tools & equipment as mentioned in the **Annexure-II** and for Rs.15,14,77,000/- as recurring expenditure towards salaries to staff, rent, other contingencies, stationery, maintenance of machineries and computers, raw materials etc., total sanction of **Rs.60,18,52,000/- (Rupees sixty crore eighteen lakh and fifty two thousand only)**, from the funds of the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board, as detailed in **Annexure-V** and also issue the following orders: -

- i. The Government may incur the recurring expenditure initially for **Rs.15,14,47,000/-** (Rs.1338.55 lakh for Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) and Rs.175.92 for hostels) towards salaries to staff, rent, other contingencies, stationery, oil and lubricants, maintenance of machineries and computers, raw materials, etc., for 7 Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) and the same should be reimbursed from the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board fund at the end of every financial year.
- ii. To sanction 189 posts (27 posts per ITI) and 49 posts (7 posts per hostel) as detailed in **Annexure – III**.
- iii. Permission is accorded to the Director of Employment and Training to outsource 42 Contract instructors (6 Junior Training Officer posts per ITI) with qualification prescribed by National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) with a consolidated pay of Rs.28,000/- per month through Overseas Manpower Corporation Limited (OMCL).
- iv. Permission is accorded to the Director of Employment and Training to recruit 7 instructors for Language cum Soft skill Lab with a consolidated pay of Rs.28,000/- per month on contract basis as per prevailing norms and to fill up the posts of sweeper through outsourcing.
- v. Permission is accorded to the Director of Employment and Training to function the Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) on rental in private premises, till the construction of own building and to pay the rent fixed by respective Public Works Department (PWD) authorities for the temporary location.

- vi. Permission is accorded to the Director of Employment and Training to start the courses from 2025 session onwards under SCVT (State Council for Vocational Training) pattern and to issue certificate.
- vii. Permission is accorded to the Principal of each Industrial Training Institute to open PD (Personal Deposit) account as per the existing procedure.
- viii. Sanction is accorded for "Express Pay Orders" to these 7 Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) under Rule 17 of the Tamil Nadu Treasury Code, Volume-I to draw salary and other bills in the Head of Account as mentioned in the **Annexure-IV**.
- ix. The District Treasury Officer concerned is authorised to assign new Drawing and Disbursing Code (DDO) to the 7 new Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) and also to supply Tamil Nadu Treasury Code 70 register for their use.
- x. Sanction of funds towards civil and electrical works for the construction of the above 7 new Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) will be considered from the funds of the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board, separately based on the detailed estimates furnished by the Public Works Department.

6. The recurring expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited under the Heads of Account as detailed in the **Annexure-V**.

7. The Director of Employment and Training is directed to remit (reimburse) the recurring expenditure with respect to the 7 Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) to the Government Account as below:

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para "5" above shall constitute an item of "**New Instrument of Service**" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially be met by drawl of an advance from the contingency fund. The Director of Employment and Training is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the contingency fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form A appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a

copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Director of Employment and Training (Training Wing) is also directed to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2025-2026 to Government in Finance (BG-I/Edn.II) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
